

Cross of San Ysidro Sunrise Hike Trail Guide

DISTANCE: .5 Mile (one way) ELEVATION: 2113' (approximate)

ELEVATION GAIN: 103' TYPE: Out-and-Back HIKING TIME: 15 minutes

RATING: Easy

Directions to Trailhead

Cross of San Ysidro 9733 North Estaban Way (closest address to trailhead) Tujunga, CA 91042

Exit the 5 onto Sunland Blvd. Proceed north 4.1 miles. Sunland Blvd. will pass under the 210 and become Foothill Blvd. Continue on Foothill Blvd. for approximately 2.66 miles and turn right onto Amoret Dr. Proceed .35 mile on Amoret to Hillhaven Ave. and turn right. Drive .1 mile to Alene Dr. and turn right. Continue another .1 mile to Verdugo Crestline Dr. and turn left. Verdugo Crestline Dr. ends in approximately .1 mile at an intersection with 3 dirt fire roads. This is the trailhead with a small parking area. Begin hiking on the fire road on the left. (Technically, this fire road is an extension of Verdugo Crestline.)



The parking area is small, but for a sunrise hike you shouldn't have any problems. Park in the small dirt area where the fire roads intersect with Verdugo Crestline Dr.



The trail begins on the dirt fire road on your left. Head West approximately .3 mile to the first Trail Junction.



At approximately .3 mile the road will split. Take the fork on your right and continue uphill for .2 mile to the Cross.



Congratulations! You've reached the Cross of San Ysidro. After the sun rises and you've got your pictures, simply retrace your steps to the parking area.
